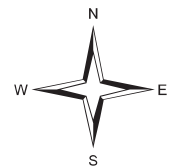
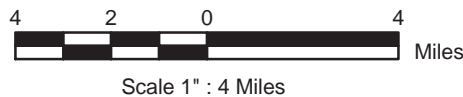
Hydrologic Soil Group Descriptions

A – High infiltration rates. Soils are deep, well drained to excessively drained sands and gravels.

B – Moderate infiltration rates. Deep and moderately deep, moderately well and well-drained soils that have moderate texture.

C – Slow infiltration rates. Soils with layers impeding downward movement of water, or soils that have moderately fine or fine textures.

D – Very slow infiltration rates. Soils are clayey, have high water table, or are shallow to an impervious layer.
